Bluebird of Chelsea and
Sigrid of Chelsea.

BLUEBIRD OF CHELSEA

Bluebird was built in 1931 by Thornycroft for Sir Malcom Campbell to commemorate his knighthood that was bestowed for breaking the land speed record with his car Bluebird.

She was one of the vessels to take part in Operationa Dynamo, the evacuation of French and British troops from the beaches of Dunkirk in 1940 and continues to take part in ceremonies marking this historical occasion. In 2012 Bluebird was part of the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Thames Pageant.

SIGRID OF CHELSEA


Sigrid of Chelsea was built by Camper & Nicholson in 1925.

Upon the outbreak of the Second world war she was requisitioned by the Admiralty where she performed a variety of duties.

She is an excellent example of a gentleman's motor yacht of the Edwardian era.
